Volunteer Role Description



Volunteer Countryside Ranger

Within this role you will work to promote conservation, recreation and environmental education within Country Parks/Visitor Centres, woodlands, local nature reserves and the wider countryside. You will assist with the maintenance and improvement of the general countryside, woodland areas and country parks that are owned by the authority. You will support Countryside Rangers with the delivery of environmental projects and activities to a wide range of people. You will also support the Countryside Access Ranger on maintaining Public Rights of Way across the Borough when required.

This opportunity will suit someone who:

- Has good communication skills.
- Enjoys working outdoors.
- Has an interest in nature.
- Ability to form relationships and work well with others.
- Ability to problem solve and work on own initiative.
- Has practical experience in relation to conservation tasks.

The training programme for this role includes:

- Manual Handling
- General Health and Safety
- Emergency First Aid (optional)

We require all volunteers to attend training as part of their role. This may be delivered in a range of ways including attending organised training sessions, work shadowing and through supervision. Training may be delivered at a range of venues.
