Urgent – General Exception - Reasons for urgency outlined below

Over the last 3 years, Redcar & Cleveland Borough Council have benefited from significant supplemental funding for substance misuse services, which has enabled lots of innovative work to be developed to increase numbers accessing treatment and recovery services. However, alongside this funding, targets have been set by the Office of Health Inequalities and Disparities (OHID) for increasing numbers in treatment. To date Redcar & Cleveland Council have not met these targets, and need to take urgent action to address this. Urgent efforts are underway to commission a piece of community work which will assertively attract people into treatment and recovery, and enable Redcar & Cleveland Council to meet its target. The deadline for the 24/25 supplemental grant to be spent, and also the date for the OHID targets to be met is 31st March 2025, just 9 months away. Commissioning this new service will need to be done as a matter of urgency to appoint a provider and for them to have time to embed their service and show their impact.
