MARINE PARADE AREA SALTBURN 20 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION ORDER 2024

Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 81 to 84 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 23rd day of August 2024 and may be cited as the Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council Marine Parade Area Saltburn Speed Restriction Order 2024.
2. The Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council Saltburn Speed Restriction Order 2022 is hereby amended by revoking the 20mph speed restriction in relation to Saltburn Road Saltburn from its junction with Marine Parade to its junction with Saltburn Bank.
3. . . Save as provided in Articles 4 and 5, this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 mph on those lengths of highway detailed in the Schedule hereto
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall make it unlawful for a person to drive in excess of 20 mph on the lengths of highway specified in the Schedule , if it is being used for police, fire and rescue or ambulance purposes.
5. Nothing in Article 3 shall make it unlawful for a person to drive in excess of 20 mph on the lengths of highway specified in the Schedule , if the vehicle is used by a member of the special forces and is being driven in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving vehicles at high speeds or for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.

MARINE PARADE AREA SALTBURN 20 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION ORDER 2024**

The Council has made the above-named Order under Sections 81 to 84 and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order which will come into operation on 23 August 2024 revokes the existing 20 mph on Saltburn Road Saltburn from its junction with Marine Parade to its junction with Saltburn Bank and imposes new 20 mph speed restrictions on the roads set out in the Schedule below. Exemptions are included in the Order for police, fire and rescue, ambulance and special forces purposes.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 9.8.24 apply to the High Court.

STATEMENT OF REASONS – 20MPH SPEED LIMIT

it is proposed to implement a 20mph speed restriction to assist in reducing vehicle speeds and maintaining road safety in the area which is frequently used by pedestrians.

It is proposed to make the order for the following reasons set out in the road traffic regulation act 1984,

- for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
